PROJECT DESCRIPTION

Total Construction has been engaged by Health Infrastructure to work with Wagga Wagga Base Hospital which is currently undergoing a major upgrade. As part of this upgrade, Total is extending the existing renal facility to cope with additional demand expected in the coming years.

The new addition is being constructed next to the existing facility which will remain operational throughout the build. Once the new building has been constructed, Total will demolish and interconnect the 2 structures. In addition, 5 rooms in the existing renal facility will be renovated.

The building is a metal clad, steel framed structure; chosen by the client as an economical building system as it is expected the building will be replaced in the future with a fully upgraded facility.

OVERCOMING CHALLENGES

The hospital and existing renal facility will remain fully operational during construction so critical to the success of the project is to ensure the continuity of services are supplied to the building. Where necessary, services will be changed over or upgraded after hours.
