PROJECT DESCRIPTION

UGL completed the construction of two plants for Shoalhaven Water, as part of the Shoalhaven City Council. Together the plants are \$100M in value, with Nowra at circa \$60M and Bomaderry at circa \$40M.

This project involved the construction of twelve buildings across two Waste Water Treatment Plant sites (WWTP) - six buildings for the Bomaderry WWTP site and six buildings for the Nowra WWTP site.

CHALLENGES

One of our challenges was operating within a live and operational site. This meant deliveries were coordinated to within a few hours, and the regional nature of the project exacerbated compliance with the requirements. Movement of people, materials and machinery around the site was constantly planned and re-planned.

INNOVATIONS

This is the first time we operated in a 'sub-contractor' position under a head contractor. We adapted our systems to reflect this situation during the project, and the client was appreciative that our documentation was generally superior than their usual subcontractors.
